Child Education Society, the apex body of Bal Bharati Public Schools all over the country, was set up in the year 1944 during the pre-independence era with an aim to preserve and foster Indian culture, heritage, tradition and ethos to uphold the vision of our elders. In order to achieve these objectives, it became obligatory for the Society to educate the young people. Thus, the Society was registered under the Registration of Societies Act, 1860.

The affairs of the Society are managed by the Board of Management consisting of eminent educationists and social workers. It is headed by Mr. Nikhil Channa, a distinguished educationist and philanthropist, as the President of the Society. The Society, at present runs 26 institutions which include 13 core schools, 13 Project schools in collaboration with the Indian Railways and National Thermal Power Corporation (NTPC). Bal Bharati Public Schools are progressive, co-educational English medium schools. Hindi enjoys its place of pride as the National Language in the school curriculum.

The schools built by the Society are set in congenial surroundings. They are housed in modern attractive buildings which are internet enabled and equipped with all requisite facilities, well stocked libraries, laboratories, computers, audio - visual equipment, facilities for creative arts, indoor as well as outdoor games and swimming pools.

Bal Bharati's educational philosophy is inspired by the maxim "आ नो भद्राः क्रतवो यन्तुववश्वतः" that is, "Let noble thoughts come to us from all sides." #### PRESCHOOL EDUCATION SYSTEM:


In line with the overarching aims of national education and its underlying principles, in preschool education system we pursue the following objectives:

- Ensuring smooth physical, mental and emotional development of children and acquisition of positive habits.
- We consider the needs of children and individual differences.





• We support in developing the psychomotor, socio-emotional, linguistic and cognitive skills of the child. The effort is to build self-care skills and prepare the child for primary education.









 We take care that the development of children grows in terms of affection, respect, cooperation, responsibility, tolerance, solidarity and sharing.





• Play-way is the best method of teaching and learning for children in this age group. All activities are arranged based on this method.





• Children are supported in developing their imaginative, creative and critical thinking skills along with communicative and self-expressive powers.









#### PRIMARY SECTION

Education in the early years is vitally important for the children to acquire basic skills where foundations are laid on which future learning can take place. If children are well motivated, enthusiastic, interested and happy then they learn more effectively. We aim to develop skills in a creative, imaginative and original way rather than imparting knowledge in closed doors. Each child is encouraged to reach the highest potential and motivated to continue learning.

"To strive for better and better services -finding solutions not excuses"- to achieve this motto of our school, we are focussing on 21<sup>st</sup> century skills where each child feels independent, safe and comfortable with their learning environment and employ their learning in real life context.

To achieve this aim, it is important that children acquire adequate knowledge and skill in other core areas like Health and Physical Education, Life skills, Value Education, Art and Work Education. Thus, the milestone is laid down for holistic development of each child to reach pinnacle of success.











#### **MIDDLE**

Here learning is a leeway and further alliance of the educational that starts of the Primary Stage. Qualitative education is offered to the students through the medium of interactive panels that make learning easy and fun.

Contradictory to the memorization and same old recitation practices to teach the students, now with modern teaching methods, interactive methods of teaching have been introduced. Modern teaching methods focus more on questioning, demonstration, explaining, practical, collaboration methods, and are more activity-based that includes storytelling, experiential learning, art integration, project-based learning, map reading, peer learning etc.

At this level, the students are motivated to participate actively in curricular and cocurricular activities and different inter house, inter school competitions.





#### **SECONDARY**

At this stage the school offers CBSE curriculum.

#### SENIOR SECONDARY

BBPS has sustained a high academic standard over the past 20 years. Through challenging academic exercise and intellectual vigour students are trained to become critical and compassionate thinkers. At the plus two level science stream is available. One language (English Core) and four electives can be selected from the list of subjects given below. The subjects offered are: Physics, Chemistry, Computer Science and Maths/Biology. Emphasis is also given to Work Experience, Physical and Health Education and General Studies which includes social issues of national and international interest.

#### Assessment of Speaking and Listening Skills (ASL) -

Keeping up with the changing times, the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) initiated a new drive to enhance the use of English Communicative Language in 2013-14 that includes a specific section of 'Assessment of Speaking and Listening Skills' for Grades 9<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> so as to facilitate a better and confident use of the language, especially for public.

#### **RESULTS 2021-22**

Our students have emerged with flying colours in SSE and SSCE Examination 2022 with 100% result. In std X & XII, the school recorded 100% pass percentage. Puja Mehta was the topper in SSE with 95.8%. Fiza Babariya bagged first position in SSCE with 96.0%.





#### SCHOOL SYSTEM AND ACTIVITIES

#### **HOUSE SYSTEM**

In order to develop the qualities of self-confidence, leadership, mutual understanding, cooperation, public speaking and to provide opportunities for team work and healthy competition in Sports, Academics, Literary and Cultural activities, the School is divided into four houses.

Several events and competitions are held throughout the year both at intra & interschool level to encourage mass participation of students.

#### STUDENT COUNCIL

To inculcate the leadership qualities in the students and to give them a feel of functioning of the administrative body, a school prefectorial board is formed each year and appointed via a



formal investiture ceremony. This team works closely with the authorities to support the institution in its everyday functioning. This student body acts as a link between the teachers and the students and also takes on the responsibility of guarding/leading the students appropriately.



#### **SCHOOL FACILITIES**

#### **MULTIPURPOSE HALL**

There is a well-equipped Multipurpose Hall fitted with good light and sound equipment. A number of student-centred activities are organised in the hall throughout the year.



#### **LIBRARY**

The school has well equipped library with more than 6800 books. Library has been regularly updated with stock of books including Encyclopaedias, Fictions, Non-fictions, Biographies, Motivational books, Competitive exam books and Reference books besides magazines. The bar-coding system has also been implemented in the library to facilitate accession process and stock taking. The library is digitalised; make it easy for students to access enriching resources.

The school has the system of classroom library from class I to VIII. These well-equipped class libraries consist of adequate copies of various titles. The well-stocked class libraries help to inculcate the habit of reading in children.







#### **ART ROOM**

The school has aesthetically well-designed Art Room to enhance the creativity, imagination, and self-expression of the students. The school organise various drawing competitions on different occasions to hone their artistic abilities.







#### **SCHOOL COMPUTER LAB**

In view of the fast-changing socio-cultural scenario and the growing need of information technology, we offer an intensive computer initiation and training to the students. The School Computer Lab is equipped with 40 well-equipped Computer Systems with modern processing capabilities. The Computer Lab is also equipped with high-speed Internet connectivity with Projector enabled System providing hands on

practical training for Students. The School's IT Department handles regular updations on the School Website and also conducts frequent trainings for Students & Faculty Members to be updated with the ever-growing world of Information Technology.





#### AUDIO VISUAL SYSTEM

The school is equipped with two high-end Video Conferencing Systems which are regularly utilised to conduct online Webinars and Training for Students and Faculty Members. The Video Conferencing System is also used for **E-Twinning Program** of the School where Students from different Schools collaborate and express their ideas through the Online Platform via Video Conferencing.





#### **COMPUTER AIDED TEACHING**

All the classrooms from Pre-School to XII are equipped with **smart class** and connected with the "Knowledge Centre" which is managed by specialists in the field.







#### **MATHEMATICS LAB**

The mathematics laboratory is a place where anybody can experiment and explore patterns and ideas. It is a place where one can find a collection of games, puzzles, and other teaching and learning material.

Our laboratory is well equipped with two dimensional and three-dimensional models, abacus, geometry box, models to understand conic sections, proof of theorems, mental maths chains, apparatus to understand the concept of mensuration, geo board, charts, TLM to give proper understanding of fractions, decimals and arithmetic progression and some useful material concerning other subjects etc.



#### SCIENCE LABS

The School has well-equipped labs for Physics, Chemistry, Biology & Computers for Secondary and Senior Secondary classes.

#### **BIOLOGY**

Biology Laboratory has been designed to accommodate around 30 students at a time to conduct experiments and project related activities. On daily basis we carry out microscopic observation, experimental investigation and project related activities. Students are engaged in making three dimensional models of endangered species of animals including working and still models on various themes.



#### **CHEMISTRY**

The modern age is an age of science & technology. In our day-to-day life the knowledge about chemistry plays an important role for the development of science education. The students for both secondary & higher secondary level take the advantage of chemistry laboratory to enhance & develop their psychomotor skills by working on investigatory project.

#### **PHYSICS**

The school has well-equipped Physics lab with different kinds of models. It gives students an extensive practical experience to supplement the theories learnt in the classroom.





#### **GAMES AND SPORTS**

We strongly believe that sports and games have positive physical and mental benefits and can help to develop a sense of camaraderie and team work in young learners. Our

school has an enviable reputation for sporting excellence with success at individual and team events at all levels. Grooming the right sporting talent in the right way is our top focus. The School promotes students participation in various outdoor and indoor games which includes cricket, football, table tennis, volleyball, badminton, weightlifting and basketball.

The school has a full - time counsellor who also acts as a special educator and regularly takes sessions to guide the students towards their all - round development so that, "Every hand is held" and "No child is left behind."



#### **Career Counselling**

Workshops catering to topics of interest are organized to help students of Std X & XII to choose the right career path by acclaimed professionals.





#### **MEDICAL EXAMINATION & FIRST AID**

Every student is examined at least twice a year with the help of Medical officer (NTPC hospital) and & a medical record is maintained.

There is a well-equipped Medical Room. The School has arrangements with NTPC, Hospital, for medical assistance and services.





#### PARENT-TEACHER ASSOCIATION

The School has a dynamic, resourceful and deeply committed Parent Teacher Association. It plays a vital role in the development and well-being of the students.



#### PARENT-TEACHER MEETING

Parent-Teacher Meetings are held on regular basis. The students' progress in studies & development in other areas are also reviewed.


#### **DISASTER MANAGEMENT**

#### SCHOOL SAFETY

For Safety Provisions, the School is well equipped with Fire Extinguishers at multiple locations. Emergency Evacuation Plan with School Map is displayed at various locations in the School Campus. Fire Safety Drills and Mock Evacuation Drills are conducted on the regular basis by the CISF Wing of the NTPC Township.

#### **SAFETY MEASURES**
